For example, the root could be set to "https://www.kaleyra.com/" and the cookie would then be available to sites in "https://www.kaleyra.com". This might be used to allow related pages to 'communicate' with each other. It is not possible to set the root domain to 'top-level' domains such as '.com' or '.co.uk' since this would allow widespread access to the cookie.

By default, cookies are visible to all paths in their domains, but at the time of creation they can be restricted to a given subpath – for example, https://www.kaleyra.com/career

### When do our cookie files expire?

Other than strictly necessary cookies, all files used by our website expire no later than 1 year after they are recorded.

## What happens if you turn off cookie files?

The consequences of turning off non-necessary cookie files for our website depends on which kind of cookies you turn off.

Your website browsing will not be limited, however, you give up the enhanced experience they might bring you.

Our website foresees the use of add-ons that will let you turn cookies on and off.
